Growing success

Usage:

- Golf course tees / Fairways / Roughs
- Sportsfields
- Home lawns
- Winter overseeding

Growth Habit and Characteristics:

- Dark green color
- Rapid establishment
- Fine leaf texture
- Low growth habit
- Adapted to soil pH range of 5.5–8.0

Performance Characteristics/Adaptations:

- Excellent gray leaf spot resistance
- 57% survival rate in salt bath containing 22,000 ppm NaCl
- Good stem and crown rust, dollar spot resistance
- High wear tolerance

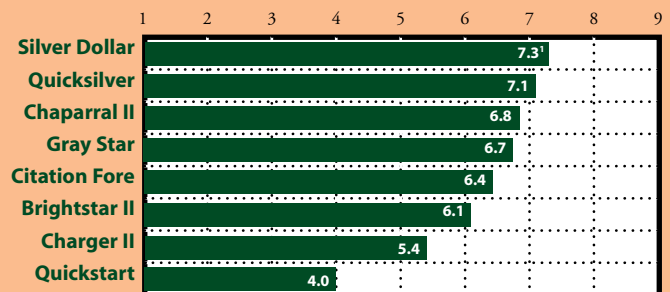
Establishment and Maintenance:

- For permanent turf, seed at 30–40 gr/m² during early fall or spring
- For winter overseeding, seed at 70–150 gr/m² depending on turf use
- Keep seedbed moist during germination and establishment
- Expect germination in 5–7 days at minimum soil temperature of 12° C, with full coverage expected in 3–6 weeks

Established Turf Maintenance:

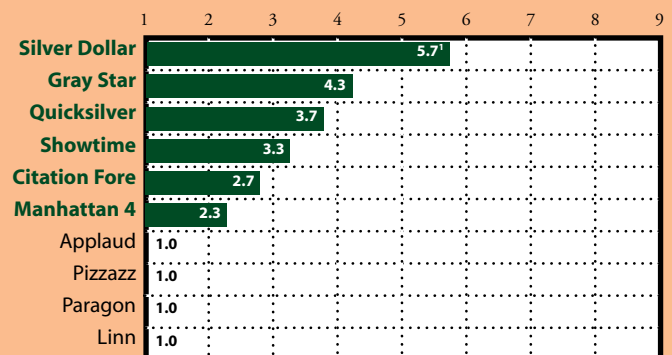
- Fertilize at 20–25 gr/m² of nitrogen per year for permanent turf
- Fertilize at 3–5 gr/m² of nitrogen per growing period for winter overseeding
- Irrigate deeply and infrequently in absence of rainfall; more lightly and frequently for overseeded turf
- Mow at 0.5–5 cm, depending on turf use

LSD (0.05) = 0.6
