The Advantages of Fairway:

- ✓ Very good cold tolerance
- ✓ Good salt tolerance
- ✓ Very good wear tolerance
- ✓ Excellent turf quality



Growing success

Usage:

- Golf course tees / Fairways / Roughs
- Residential / Commercial turf / Sports turf
- Fall overseeding programs

Growth Habit and Characteristics:

- Bunch-type growth habit with fine blade width / low upright growth
- Very uniform, dense turf with medium green color and quick establishment
- Performs well in a wide range of soil types, pH range of 5.5–8.0

Performance Characteristics/Adaptations:

- Improved insect tolerance
- Among the most cold-tolerant perennial ryegrasses
- Able to germinate at 10,000 ppm saline conditions
- Very quick to establish
- Excellent spring transition in fall overseeding situations
- Very good wear tolerance
- Good spring green-up
- Tolerates full sun to light shade
- Very good performance under low to high maintenance
- Mixes well with improved perennial ryegrass, Kentucky bluegrass and fine fescue

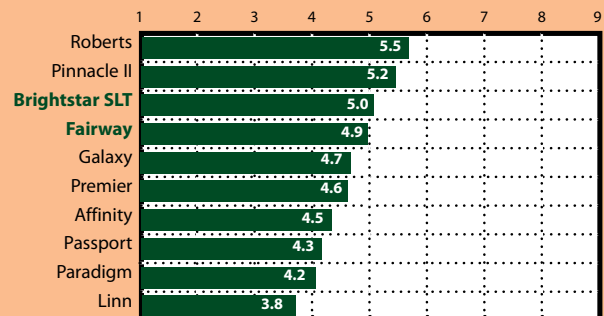
Establishment and Maintenance:

- Seed at 10–15 gr/m²
- Early fall and spring seeding are best. Late spring / summer plantings not recommended in most locations
- Seedbed should be kept moist during germination and early establishment
- Germinates in 14–21 days with optimal soil temperatures, 12°–26° C
- Full coverage in 8–10 weeks
- First mowing recommended when turf reaches approximately 5 cm

Established Turf Maintenance:

- For best results, fertilize at annual rate of 20–25 gr/m² of nitrogen
- Deep, infrequent irrigation best during cooler months / increase frequency during the summer months / to assist spring transition, reduce irrigation
- Recommended mowing height of 1–5 cm
